

Crane Supervisor NVQ Level 3

Introduction

The aim of this qualification is to recognise the knowledge, skills and competence demonstrated by an individual in the workplace. This Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Controlling Lifting Operations - Supervising Lifts provides the opportunity for individuals who specialise in co-ordinating, controlling, organising and supervising lifting operations using lifting equipment to demonstrate their competence.

What does the course include?

The NVQ covers the following units:

- Legislation, regulations and Codes of Practice relating to lifting duties
- Safe systems of work including method statements
- Personal responsibilities
- Cranes: types and terms
- Crane documentation
- Crane stability, duty charts and safety devices
- Crane appreciation
- British Standard 7121
- The role of crane supervisor
- The role of appointed person
- Preparing an area, with exclusion zones

How long is the course?

The duration of a Level 3 NVQ varies depending on the candidate, their level of experience and the work they are undertaking. We advise that the majority of NVQ Level 3's are completed between 6 and 9 months from induction.

Why do I need it?

Any person or employee that works in construction and needs to obtain a CSCS Blue Card and nationally recognised qualification in this trade.

What Qualification do I get?

For those who successfully complete the course you will be awarded a Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Controlling Lifting Operations - Supervising Lifts certificate.

What can I do next?

Achievement of this qualification provides opportunities to progress to further qualifications and training such as: Technical, supervisory and management qualifications or positions within their own organisations.

Where can I train?

The training can be delivered on your site if it meets the course requirements or at one of our three training centres situated throughout the UK.
